- Maintain an effective working relationship with the Client's staff, contractors and other consultants.
- Communicate relevant inspection and project information to the Construction Manager, Client's engineering and operations personnel, and other key project personnel. Report any site issues and potential delays or risks.

- Abide by RAM's and Prime Contractor's safety program and WorkSafe BC Regulations and reporting unsafe activities to responsible supervisor.
- Attend preconstruction meetings and other project meetings as necessary. Produce meeting minutes where required.
- Monitor construction works to ensure compliance with the contract documents, including drawings, specifications and permit requirements.
- Monitor the quality of work, identifying deficiencies in materials and workmanship and elevating as necessary.
- Inform the Project Engineer/Manager of any non-conformance to the contract documents and creates a non-conformance report for tracking.
- Maintain detailed documentation and photographic record of inspected works, including completion of Daily Inspection Reports.
- May be required to track cost and schedule data, verify Contractor's labour, equipment and materials use, and participate in review of Contractor's change requests or claims.
- May be required to record and/or verify as-constructed field measurements and red-line construction prints for record drawings.

➔ Ideal Candidate Requirements

- Candidates must be willing to travel and work in remote areas in interior BC. Shift rotations negotiable.

Preferred Experience:

- No less than 8 years of construction management experience, or a combination of less experience and a degree/diploma in civil or mechanical engineering.
- One or more of the following certifications:
 - API-1169 Pipeline Inspector Certification
 - NACE Coating Inspector Certification
 - CWB Welding Inspector Certification
